"IMEC's conducive learning environment would bring potential benefits in line with the Economic Transformation Programme to make the country a developed nation by 2020," Mohamad Kadim said, adding the cost of the postgraduates programmes started from RM8,500 per annum.

"There are three intakes yearly – February, July and September. The first intake is expected to start this July.

Meanwhile, Lee said, although Country Heights is known as a property developer for 30 years, the company believed that its motto 'Ever Searching for Better Living' included having a better education for society.
