

STPM RESULT BY PRE-U STUDENTS AT SMK PENGIRAN DATUK PENGIRAN GALPAM UNEXPECTED - PRINCIPAL

SANDAKAN, March 2 (Bernama) -- The 2015 Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia (STPM) result for the first batch of pre-university students of Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Datuk Pengiran Galpam of 92 per cent passes is unexpected, said the school principal, Hussien Abdul Manaf.

He said 164 students sat for STPM at the school last year and 151 of them passed the examination.

He said the result was unexpected because the candidates were the first batch of pre-university students at the school who were selected from five schools, namely, Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan (SMK) Datuk Pengiran Galpam, SMK Sandakan, SM Sung Siew, SM St Mary and SMK Tiong Hua.

Hussein said the 22 students passed with national Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 and above.

Meanwhile, Science student Leong Mei Tung was named the Best Student with 2A, 2B+ and a CGPA of 3.83.

The oldest of two siblings, Leong was ecstatic and satisfied with the result she obtained and planned to further her studies in engineering at University Sains Malaysia.

"I believe in the principle that a student must excel in her studies to have a better future," she added.

Another student, Lee Vun Hou, who in from the arts stream, was also announced the Best Student of the school. She scored 1A, 2B+, 1B and a CGPA of 3.67.

He attributed his success to spending at least an hour a day for revision.
