ABOUT THE GRANT

DESCRIPTION

The Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) Grant provides funding for disciplinary experts to conduct SoTL studies to improve teaching and learning practices at UNIMAS via systematic inquiry. All proposals, except those that are theoretical in nature, should include evidence-based approach to identify good teaching or learning practices and discuss how the expected outcomes of the work contribute to the improvement of student learning either within a course, programme, or institution. The studies may employ qualitative, quantitative, computational and/or any other relevant research methods.

AMOUNT OF FUNDING

In the range of RM 5,000 to RM 20,000.

FUNDING PERIODS

The funding periods are 12 to 18 months.

TYPES OF EXPENSES

Funding may be used but not limited to the following types of expenses:

- Research assistant
- Travel and transportation
- Local Conference presentation
- Rental
- Minor modifications and repairs
- Special services

ELIGIBILITY

All full-time UNIMAS academics are invited to submit proposals for SoTL Grant.
