KUCHING: Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (Unimas) has put up a board in memory of Rasli Buang, one of the nation's heroes, at the Buntal Esplanade here yesterday.

According to a representative from Unimas, the board was designed specially by Faculty of Creative and Applied Arts lecturer Dr Yaakup Rafiee to display the heroism of Rasli Buang, who came from Kampung Buntal, against the communists.

"This activity is also part of the results from Unimas' community transformation project which was led by lecturers from the Faculty of Science and Technology Resources.

"In addition, this was held in conjunction with the Unimas Strategic Plan Retreat with Board of Directors," said the representative.
