Azman said he was devastated, worried that he would not be able to further his tertiary education and fulfil his ambition to become a lecturer.

"I had just finished my matriculation studies in Labuan College early this year. I was riding on a motorcycle with my cousin on our way home after supper past midnight along Jalan Matang when a motorist from the opposite direction lost control of his vehicle and knocked into us.

"I was very down after the accident but after a while, I pulled myself together as I am still alive and I will not give up. I'm very grateful that I am accepted to study at Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (Unimas)," he told reporters here yesterday.
