KUCHING: A forum on 'University-Community Partnership for Indigenous Community Resilience' will be held at Wisma Bapa Malaysia in

Petra Jaya today.

Jointly organised by Sarawak Development Institute (SDI) Universiti Malaysia and Sarawak (Unimas), the halfday forum aims to educate participants on how to build upon research conducted to enhance and strengthen the infrastructural needs of the Penan community in Long Lamai, upper Baram.

It is also to explore the feasibility
