## INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

*Hamadryad* (issued annually) publishes original papers dealing with, but not necessarily restricted to, the herpetology of Asia. Reviews of major papers and books are also published.

Manuscripts should be submitted in duplicate, typewritten on one side of the paper. Papers previously published or submitted for publication elsewhere should not be submitted. Manuscripts on disks (IBM-compatible only) are requested. For general style, contributors are asked to examine the current issue of *Hamadryad*. Authors having access to publication funds are requested to pay US\$ 5 per printed page of their papers to help defray production costs.

Major papers exceed four pages (double space typescript) should contain the following headings: abstract, five to eight key words, introduction, material and methods, results, discussion, literature cited. New species descriptions will be considered as major papers regardless of size. Abstracts should contain the important points of the paper, avoiding references. Footnotes are not allowed. Tables should follow the main body of the manuscript. Black and white photographs and colour slides are accepted if these are sharp and show good contrast. Black and white photos should be printed on glossy paper at least 6" x 8" and should be attached to white Bristol boards that carry the name of the author and of the manuscript. Illustrations should be preferably done with India ink on good quality tracing paper. All lettering should be done with transfers.

All papers will be refereed. Authors of papers dealing with range extensions and descriptions of new species should deposit their material in established zoological collections and cite museum registration numbers.

Twenty-five copies of reprints (fifty in case of two or more authors) will be provided gratis.
