- d. Accept the adjudicators' decision.

#### During the debates, adjudicators will:

- a. Treat the occasion, other adjudicators and the debaters with respect;
- b. Respect the rules of the competition;
- c. Not disrupt or detract from a debater's speech;
- d. Announce the result;
- e. Explain the reasoning for their decision;
- f. Limit their adjudication to ten minutes;
- g. Make constructive comments to assist debaters.
