

The Prevalence And Associated Factors Of Smoking Among Barambangan Adults In Kudat, Sabah

Smoking is the number one leading causes of preventable death worldwide due to tobacco-related illness (WHO, 2010). In Malaysia, Sabah is considered as one of the highest prevalence of smoking state. The aimed of this study was to determine the prevalence and associated factors of smoking in among Barambangan community in Sabah. A quantitative and cross-sectional study design were used. The prevalence of smoking among adults in Barambangan was 42.7% (n=41).

The traditional Malay dwellings in Sarawak may have followed the central tenet of a Malay house that has been established in previous researches of that in the Malaysian Peninsular, but due to the differences in culture, history (origin and colonization), topography and exposure of the Sarawak Malays to the other indigenous groups ethnics, the dwellings of the Sarawak Malay may have some distinguished typology that has yet to be unraveled. By studying the characteristics of selected houses in Kampung Seberang Hilir, the northbank kampongs of Kuching's Sarawak River, and comparing them with that of Peninsular Malaysia, distinctive characteristics possessed by Sarawak Malay houses could be distinguished and defined. The culture and lifestyle in the Malay kampongs will also be put into detailed study as to investigate the kampong environment of this particular native race of Sarawak.
