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Abstract

The ongoing development of Malay literature has generated a line of remarkable authors in this country's literary endeavors. The National Laureate award serves as an initiative toward establishing more outstanding authors as well as encouraging the production of quality works that may be taken as a guidance for the community in addressing today's challenging daily issues. In keeping with the passage of time, this study analyses the novels of the third millennium era's National Laureates, namely the novel Orang Kota Bharu (2003), Naratif Ogonshoto (2001), Delima Ranting Senja (2009), and Cengkaman Hasrat (2015), in order to identify thoughts or discourses that are relevant and significant to community education in this country as presented in their work. The method of content analysis of the novels studied was used in this qualitative study. The analysis is based on Lukacs' (1963, 1978, 1898, 1990) realism perspective.
