MoU on training courses

KUCHING: A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), was signed yesterday between Sarawak Skills Development Centre, (SSDC), Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (UNIMAS), L&G Twintech Institute of Technology and Institute of Management Malaysia (MIM).

The aim of the MoU is to

increase the types of training courses offered by SSDC in order to meet the increasing demand for skilled industrial workers in Sarawak.

Under the MoU, Sarawak Skills Development Centre will launch three new programmes - the Development Skills in Office Technology Programme (Unimas),
