

CM receives visitors from Shell and Unimas

KUCHING – Chief Minister Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Dr Haji Abdul Taib Mahmud yesterday morning received a farewell call by the outgoing Executive Director of Shell Gas and Power Malaysia Heng Hock Cheng at Menara Pelita in Petra Jaya here.

Heng, who has served for five years in the country, is on transfer to Beijing as Managing Director for Shell Gas and Power Division, China.

Accompanying Heng during the visit was his successor, Idris Jala, a former vice president of retail marketing based in London.

Later, the Chief Minister received a courtesy call by a six-member delegation from the organising committee of the Conference on Information Technology in Asia (CITA) 2003 led organising chairman Professor Datuk Yusuf Hadi from Unimas.
