

International engineering conference in July

KOTA SAMARAHAN: The Sixth International Engineering Conference (EnCon) will be held here from July 1 to 4 with the theme, 'Energy and Environment'.

It is organised by the Faculty of Engineering, Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (Unimas) with the Centre of Excellence in Renewable Energy (CoERE) and Quaid-e-Awam University of Engineering Science and Technology (QUEST), Pakistan.

The conference will enable the sharing of ideas and latest technological advances in fields relevant to the theme among researchers, academicians, engineers and industrial professionals.

EnCon has been organised annually since 2007, except in 2009, attracting over 400 participants worldwide.

Its chairman Assoc Prof Dr Andrew Ragai Henry Rigit from the Faculty of Engineering, Unimas said EnCon had received approximately 100 technical abstracts and papers not only from Malaysia, but also from around the globe.

Among the key focus of the conference are Advanced Manufacturing Technology, Conventional and Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency and Green Technology, Modeling and Simulation, Power Generation and Distribution, Smart Materials for Energy Efficiency, Thermal Engineering, Waste Water Management and special topics on Energy and Environment cycles. Papers related to other relevant topics are also acceptable for inclusion in the proceedings.
