Unimas secures RM500,000 grant from Higher Education Ministry

KOTA SAMARAHAN: Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (Unimas) has secured nearly RM500,000 in Knowledge Transfer Programme (KTP) grant from the Higher Education Ministry.

The grant, worth RM455,661, will

fund Unimas' community and industry-related projects in Sarawak for two years.

The recipients of the grant are Prof Dr Lau Seng in collaboration with Pro-Auto Care Centre Sdn Bhd to develop fuel-cells for vehicles to

improve their fuel economy and carbon footprint, Assoc Prof Dr Alvin Yeo for e-commerce capacity building among the Penan community in Long Lamai, Baram, and Dr Wan Azlan Wan Zainal Abidin to develop a micro-hydro project in Kampung

Semulung Ulu, Sri Aman.

The Knowledge Transfer Programme (KTP) was launched by Higher Education Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Khaled bin Nordin on June 26.

The objective of the grant is to

recognise and promote the transfer of knowledge through the exchange of creative and innovative ideas, research findings, experience and skills between higher learning institutions, industries, government agencies and the community.
